Child Care Worker (permanent part time)

Primary duties include:

- Establish and maintain a healthy, safe, and enjoyable childcare environment for a variety of ages.
- Manage child behaviours in a group setting using best practices.
- Maintain documentation as assigned.
- Establish and maintain program routines.
- Maintain a standard of cleanliness in the childcare room.
- Facilitate age-appropriate opportunities for children to play.
- Provide basic care (feeding, diapering, etc.).
- Communicate and collaborate within a team.

Our ideal candidate will have:

- Current First Aid/CPR certification
- Early Childhood Education or Child and Youth Care Diploma are preferred. Will consider equivalent education & related experience.
