The Medicine Hat Women's Shelter Society supports families and individuals who are experiencing family violence by providing them with safe shelter, education, advocacy and access to community resources. We are currently looking for an enthusiastic individual to join our outreach team.

Duties Include (but are not limited to):

- Provide preventative and intervention services on calls relating to domestic, family violence/conflicts and senior abuse.
- Provide an immediate response to individuals affected by domestic/family violence, facilitate early assessment of level of risk and create a community service plan.
- Provide support, advocacy, crisis intervention, resource information, referrals, public education, and training.
- Work towards achieving a healthy, safe, and supportive environment free from the cycle of violence for participants.
- Contribute to the growth and development of the programs and services offered by the outreach team.

Our ideal candidate will have:

- B.S.W. and/or a degree or diploma in social work or other human services field.
- Knowledge and understanding of family violence.
- Experience in outreach services, including intensive case management, intervention, behavioral interviewing, wrap around supports, group facilitation and advocacy (combination of related education/experience will be considered)
- Experience facilitating groups.
- Two years' related experience is preferred.
- Current Standard First Aid/CPR and ASIST.
- Valid Alberta driver's license.

Rate of Pay: starting wage is \$21.79/hour; extensive benefit package available after 3 months, 3 weeks paid vacation.
