- Manage child behaviours in a group setting using "best practise" strategies
- Maintain documentation as assigned
- Establish and maintain program routines
- Maintain a standard of cleanliness in the child care room
- Facilitate age appropriate opportunities for children to play and have fun
- Provide basic care (feeding, diapering, etc.)
- Communicate and collaborate with a team

### **Our ideal candidate will have:**

- Current First Aid/CPR certification
- Early Childhood Education or Child and Youth Care Diploma are preferred. Equivalent education & related experience may be considered.
