



Children's Summer Program Worker (2 student positions)

Qualifications: Suitable candidates must be enrolled in a post-secondary program such as Child & Youth Care, Social Work, Education or other human services related field; possess a valid driver's license and submit a clear and current police record check and child welfare intervention record check prior to commencement of employment. Preference will be given to individuals who enjoy spending time with children and who have a working knowledge and understanding of family violence and related implications.

Applicant **MUST** have attended school in the 2018/2019 school year and be under 30 years of age as per the Canada Summer Jobs grant requirements.

Role Summary: The Children's Summer Program Worker provides support to children 6-12 years of age who are impacted by family violence, and represents the Medicine Hat Women Shelter Society vision, mandate and philosophy to the community at large. The worker will work within a team-based environment demonstrating an ability to be adaptable in meeting the needs of the agency and the individuals that are served. They must demonstrate behavior management, decision making and communication skills. This is a temporary position that will run for a period of 10 weeks, starting June 19th, 2019 and concluding August 28th, 2019.

Responsibilities and duties:

Applying helping skills within a family violence framework to assist children to regain a sense of confidence, to build and develop life skills that promote healthy living, stress reduction and social responsibility. This is accomplished by scheduling and coordinating educational, recreation and social activities at the facility and within the community and surrounding area. The Children's Summer Program Workers will work collaboratively with clients, volunteers, other staff members and community partners to ensure and promote an effective delivery of services for children.

Rate of pay: \$16.50/hr, 8am – 4pm (40 hours per week), Monday – Friday. Not required to work on general holidays including Canada Day (July 1st) and Heritage Day (August 5th).
